

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GREEN CLOSE, STURMINSTER NEWTON

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along GREEN CLOSE, STURMINSTER NEWTON between its junctions with B3091 and Filbridge Rise, a distance of approximately 90 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 20 June 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 June 2022.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out a supply separation.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3091
