

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER A357, SHILLINGSTONE

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:00 until 16:00 on 25th March 2021 and will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport if necessary; however, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30th March 2021.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

The effect of the order will be:

- [i] All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A357, Shillingstone between the junction with Hine Town Lane and the junction with Bere Marsh (in both directions), a distance of approximately 1450 metres.
- [ii] To impose a clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along A357 between the junction with Hine Town Lane and the junction with Bere Marsh (in both directions). Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
