The Chair made the Committee aware of a resubmitted Planning Application for the old Snooks Yard. There have been minor changes made to the application. This will be considered at the Town Council meeting on 1 April 2026.

**The Public Consultation extension of 30mph limit on A357**

The following statement will be submitted –

We refer to the consultation regarding the proposed extension of the 30 mph limit at Rolls Mill, Sturminster Newton. Sturminster Newton Town Council are supportive of this proposal and are also supportive of comments forwarded in a letter from the residents of Newton.

It is a matter of concern that the current residential development at Rolls Mill is for 48 affordable house which will, inevitably, suit the younger age group with young families. Additionally, proposed further development to the west of the current development and the proposed Aldi supermarket at Rolls Mill (we are informed by Dorset Cllr Jones that we may expect to be in receipt of a planning application for the supermarket shortly) will no doubt result not only in a significant increase in traffic in the area but also, an increase in pedestrians crossing a very busy main road. In the interest of public safety, we would strongly request the installation of a central refuge to allow safe crossing .

**Tree Matters:**

There were three matters to report:

- Ham Gate – removal of trees due to damage of roof and solar panels.
- Bridge Car Park – two maples removed.
- Sequoia, Brinsley Close – removal of two fruit trees.
