Cllr Mantock – reported that the retaining wall of a property adjacent to Ricketts Lane Recreation Ground has now collapsed and is dangerous, she felt this is a health & safety issue that needs to be urgently addressed, she asked if it could be discussed by the Amenities committee.

Cllr Donaldson – reported that he had heard rumours the second phase of the Wyatt development has been placed on hold due to the sales figures. He also advised that a representative of Dorset & Wiltshire Fire & Rescue Service (DWFRS) had assured him that the town that we will not lose the remaining pump in the cuts being made. He finally shared that members of the public had enquired as to whether there was any information regarding future usage of the former Factory Shop premises.

Cllr Batstone – Asked if the Neighbourhood Plan review needed to be restarted.
